

Several Units of EL2.1s and DRY2.1 Can Be Connected Together



In order to manage the hydrogen purge in a simple way, simply connect as many devices together as needed.

The recommended way to do this is to combine up to five EL2.1s (35 bar version) or two EL2.1s (8 bar version) and one DRY2.1 in a 19" rack and to then connect the purge lines via a common line.




To download the app, scan the QR-code with your Android or Apple mobile phone or visit <u>app.enapter.com</u>

If you can't scan the QR code, enter the device ID and PIN manually. You can find them in the back of the device.






Dryer is ready for use!

H2 in port is connected to the hydrogen output line of your electrolysers.

H2O out port is connected to your hydrogen storage.

H2 purge port is connected to your hydrogen purge outlet.

Plug the power cable into the Power Port. Make sure the electrical ground is at the top G G N L
